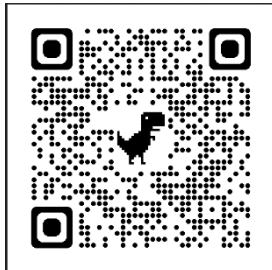
Aims - The module will enable students to develop an individualised approach and demonstrate evidence-based management of adults and children with a range of minor ailments.

- Gynaecology and emergency contraception
- Minor gastrointestinal presentations
- Non-traumatic musculoskeletal conditions and back pain
- Management of genitourinary conditions in primary care
- Nutrition related conditions
- Related psycho-social issues well-being
- Eye conditions, Ear Nose and Throat and Upper Respiratory Tract conditions
- Skin Conditions Infectious and Immune Related
