Course Overview

This interactive course is delivered online and consists of five modules over five months:

- Module 1 – Structures and knowing your workforce. Friday 13th February 2026
- Module 2 – Learning Environments. Friday 13th March 2026
- Module 3 – Workforce Transformation. Friday 17th April 2026
- Module 4 – Organising Training. Friday 15th May 2026
- Module 5 – Workforce Matter. Friday 19th June 2026

All sessions will take place between 9:30am and 12pm. **Learners must be able to commit to all the sessions and complete the required reading for the course in advance of each session.**

Individuals, both clinical and non-clinical, looking to consolidate and expand their knowledge, enabling them to take up roles such as (list not exhaustive):

Applicants should have worked within primary care for a minimum two years and have an interest in primary care workforce training and education.
